
PREPARING TO SELL YOUR HOME?

- The Minnesota REALTORs® suggests that sellers dispose of unwanted medications at a local disposal site prior to showing their home.






Addiction Begins at Home

REMEMBER: STORE SECURELY & DISPOSE SAFELY

DO:

- Store your medicines safely away from children and others who may take your medicine without your knowledge or permission. This may mean locking up your medicine in a safe, or another secure location.
- Dispose of unused or expired medications safely by taking them to an approved disposal site.



DON'T:

- Flush pills or medication down the drain or toilet. Flushing pollutes drinking water and can harm aquatic life.
- Throw pills or medication in the trash.
 Misuse can occur once the medication
 leaves your home. Always opt for a
 secure disposal site.
